Renting the Cabin of the Crazy One

The Cabin of the Crazy One provides a safe yet isolated environment, surrounded by the natural beauty of the San Luis Valley. The window behind the shrine reveals the majesty of Ritro Gönpö and the other beautiful Sangre de Cristo mountains. The balcony outside the second floor looks out onto the vast San Luis Valley and across to the horizon for some of the most beautiful and inspiring sunsets you'll ever see.

Deer, elk, and other wildlife visit near the cabin from time to time; it's truly an inspiring place to practice. One can practice inside with the shrine, or use the platform on the balcony for sky-gazing and working with the elements.

The cabin is solar-powered. The kitchen has a refrigerator and the cooking stove is propane-fired for cooking your meals. There are two sinks for doing dishes, water is provided in large jugs. The kitchen is equipped with all the basics, cups, plates, silverware, etc. A wood-burning stove keeps the cabin warm in winter. There is also enough space in the shrine room to do full length prostrations if that is your practice.

Fees:

Less than one week:	\$25/day
One week:	\$175
Two weeks:	\$300 or \$21.50 per day up to 14 days
Three weeks:	\$425 or \$20.00 per day up to 21 days
Four or more weeks:	\$500 or \$18.00 per day up to 28 days

Retreat Masters:

You are encouraged to enlist the support of a local retreat master, should you need one. Inexperienced retreatants and longer retreats are most likely to require retreat master assistance.

This role includes: Periodic written communication during your retreat, shuttling water and food from the center, going shopping for fresh produce on your behalf, or cleaning the cabin when you are done. Some retreat masters can provide meditation instruction and retreat guidance.

The on/premises Retreat Center Manager will check in with you before and after your retreat and is available to assist you with any questions you may have. The Retreat Center Manager will also be responsible for ensuring that the cabin is clean and ready for your retreat. General use policy

We want the cabin to be in use as much as possible, as it affects the environment as well as other retreatants in a very positive way. You may use the cabin even while there are programs occurring at the Dharma Ocean Retreat Center down below, but please maintain your retreat boundary during that time. The cabin is not available as a program housing option by registered participants.
